
BOX TOPS FOR EDUCATION




Nothing Beats That New Car Smell

I had the pleasure of dropping by the maker space and witnessing the spark of innovation and problem-solving in action. Students were challenged to build the tallest tower possible using




touch each other. The results were nothing short of impressive—take a look at some of these fantastic creations!

Sure, our feet may have gotten a bit wet, but we learned all about the delicate ecosystems of the salt marsh and the tidal pools, which are home to a variety of plants and animals, such as fish, crabs, invertebrates, wading birds, and mammals. Pollution and water flow modifications often threaten these delicate ecosystems.



Students learned about the soil, plant colors, & of course, everyone's favorite, the rotten egg odor due to low oxygen levels in the peat, a water-logged, spongy material made from decomposing plant matter.






















